## Frequently Asked Questions

**What are Family Commitment Hours and how do I fulfill them?**

We all paid a \$150 Family Commitment Fee and received a blue 15-hour card at Registration. When you attend a Booster Club meeting or help at school-related events, your card will be signed for each hour of volunteer time you contributed.

**Note:** Please have your Family Commitment Card signed **within 2 weeks** of the event to receive credit.

Once all 15 hours have been completed, you will receive your \$150 Family Commitment Fee back. For those of you interested in volunteering an **additional 15 hours**, you will be invited to a special lunch with Ms. Gerardo at the end of the school year!

All Family Commitment Cards  
 (Blue 15-Hour and Pink Additional 15-Hour)  
 are both due April 3, 2025.
